
Our First Term

We are starting our learning with a 2 week focus in literacy on the book Change Sings by Amanda Gorman.

In Maths we are starting off with Place Value and understanding Hundreds Tens and Ones and both reading and writing digits in a number. Ask your children which strategies they have been using to explore number!
