Welcome to Radley Foundation Stage Unit

The Foundation Stage Unit caters for children from 3 years old to their entry to primary school in the Reception Year.

All children have an entitlement to 15 hours of government funded provision from the long term after their third birthday. **Please note that we do not split funding with another provider.**

Extra sessions, if available, are charged for separately at £15.00 per session.

For working parents of three and four-year-olds the government will provide a further 15 hours, making 30 hours a week in total (10 sessions) of funding.

You can register your child when they are 2 years old. Please ask the school office for a Registration form.

Parents will be offered five sessions and are asked to take a minimum of three. Sessions may be taken over full or part days.

Emergency sessions may be requested up to 24 hours in advance in difficult circumstances for a charge of £30.00, if places are available in the Foundation Stage Unit.

Our session times are:

Monday to Friday (term time only)

9am—12 noon (Mornings)

9am—3pm (All day)

Admissions

Parents should be aware that entry to the Foundation Stage Unit does not automatically lead to a place in the school and the Local Authority admissions process for children entering Reception in any primary school should be followed. Our admissions policy is available for parents to read.

We are able to take children from Radley and the surrounding area into our Foundation Stage Unit whether or not they will apply to attend the primary school.

We have excellent transition procedures to all our local primary schools and will ensure

that your child's early experiences in our Foundation Stage Unit help to smooth their transition to school.
