Dear Parents,

As you will be aware the Year 6 SATs (KS2 National Curriculum Tests) are almost here. We have started the summer term by 'upping our game'! Our expectations are high for every child as we work towards the tests.

Thank you for everything you do at home encouraging and supporting the children with their learning. Homework for Year 6s is changing slightly this term, and each week your child will be bringing home an arithmetic and a grammar booklet which will include questions on a particular area of their learning. We will start the children off with these booklets in class, and we ask them to continue with or complete the questions at home. We advise that the children keep their booklets at home rather than bringing them back to school, so that they can use them to recap their learning. However, if the children have any questions, or are unsure of anything, they are more than welcome to ask us for help!

As the evenings become lighter, we really appreciate your support in helping your child to get plenty of sleep: this makes such a difference to their focus in class.

This year the tests will take place on the following days:

Tues 14 May 2024	English Reading	
Wed 15 May 2024	Mathematics Paper 1: Arithmetic Mathematics Paper 2: Reasoning	
Thurs 16 May 2024	Mathematics Paper 3: Reasoning	

During the week of the SATs we will be holding a Breakfast Club, for those Year 6 children who would like to attend. The Club is completely optional, but should your child not wish to come to the Breakfast Club could we please ask you to **ensure they are in school by 8.45 on all the test days.** 

The Breakfast Club will take place on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday mornings in the school hall and will begin at 8:15. Please return the below slip to indicate when your child will be attending.

We will offer a continental style breakfast of fruit juice, a breakfast pastry, a cereal bar and fruit. There will be no charge for this. However, if your child would normally have a more substantial breakfast, could they please have something at home first, and treat the Club as more of a 'second breakfast'!

We will also be offering a biscuit, piece of fruit and a drink mid-morning on the days of the tests, for those children who would like them.
