This term's cross curricular topic is all about **Toys** and our science sessions are focusing on **Everyday Materials**. Below are ideas for Home Learning Activities in the next few weeks. Please select which activity or activities you would like to work on. You can choose one task or more. We would like to share at least one of your pieces of topic work in the week beginning: Monday 7th February.

Activities:

Toys:

1. Make a simple board game. You could make it all about toys.
2. Read some stories about toys and then plan and write your own story. You could make it into a book with illustrations.
3. Interview someone in your family about what toys were like when they were a child. Plan what you want to ask first and then write a short report with what you find out.
4. Investigate how teddy bears have changed through time. You could make a timeline to show bears from the past up to the present day.

Everyday Materials:

1. Can you find some objects at home that are made of at least 3 different materials? Draw your object and record the materials.
2. Make a poster about materials, explaining the main types of materials and their properties.

4. Make a model with as many different materials as you can. Keep a record of what you have used. Who will manage the most?
