Achievements

Despite being hampered by Covid-19 restrictions at the start of the academic year, we are super pleased that we raised over £5,000 for the school in 2021/22! This was achieved due to the collective support and generosity of the families of Radley Primary School and our local community. Due to this achievement we have been able to:

- Fund the project to create 'The Sanctuary'. The Sanctuary is an area of calm and quiet available to be used by children as a designated safe space for when they feel their emotions may be running too high and need to regain their emotional and physical control
- Refurbishment of the library. Helping to provide aesthetic improvements to the library area to make it more welcoming for the children
- Covering the cost of the Christmas pantomime in the school for the children

The additional money that has been raised will be used to fund future projects

Fundraising activities conducted in the 2021/22 academic year

- December 2021: Christmas raffle and the production of Christmas mugs, cards and lanterns
 The children had a great time selecting the raffle tickets and seeing who had won a prize during a
 school assembly there were lots of happy faces leaving the school that day. The children also
 loved seeing their creations come to life with their drawings being put on mugs and cards, plus
 creating festive lanterns
- February 2022: Movie and snack event after school

 We screened Encanto which the children loved watching and singing along to the songs. "We don't talk about Bruno, no, no, no"
- April 2022: Easter quiz trail and Easter bonnet competition

The children enjoyed wandering the village, following the clues and working out the winning answer to enter a prize draw. They also looked great in their Easter bonnets and there was a winner from each year group

- June 2022: School disco, game stalls at Radley Flower Show and a bake stall at Radley College June was a busy month! There were a lot of happy faces at the school disco and the children had such a fun time. A great time was had by all playing games and winning prizes at the Radley Flower Show. There were also a lot of happy faces whilst enjoying the cakes sold at the Radley College Picnic in the Park bake stall over £900 was raised at this one event alone. People definitely like cake
- July 2022: Celebration Day drinks and snacks
 To help re-energise the parents and children after sports day and to support the fun of Celebration
 Day, we had Pimms, soft drinks and snacks available
