We would like the children to select **at least two different tasks**. We will share the pieces of topic work in the week beginning **Monday 6<sup>th</sup> February**. You are also welcome to send in photos, if easier.

### Our School and Locality:

1. Make a map of how you get to school. Don't forget to add labels and/ or a Key.
2. Interview a parent, grandparent or other family member on their school days. Make sure that you prepare your questions first. What do you think are the main differences compared to your school days?

2. Using the information from above, make a poster, book or PowerPoint showing the different groups of animals.
3. Make a quiz all about animals or about one animal in particular.
4. Make a 3 D representation of one of your favourite animals (could be clay, Lego or any medium you choose) with an information card to go with it (as if it was going to be displayed in an Exhibition or Museum).
5. Find out information on how to look after an animal that can be kept as a pet. If possible, you could interview a family member who has a pet. Write a set of instructions on how to care for this pet.
