Spellings are set on a Monday and your child will come home with a spelling list on that day. The children will be tested on these spellings on Friday.

Homework will be set for children on a Friday and will be stuck into their orange homework books. There will usually be a maths task, game or activity to do, and also a literacy, topic or other subject task. If there are any concerns over homework, or if one week your child cannot complete the task for a valid reason, please write in the homework book to let us know.

Also, if your child is spending too long on homework let us know, as we would like the homework tasks to be enjoyable as well as to aid learning. If possible, we would like the homework book back by Wednesday in order to allow us to look at the homework before setting the next task, but the children can bring it in on Thursday or Friday if they have taken longer to complete the work.

We also encourage you to continue reading with your child, listening to them read and discussing their reading. Comprehension skills and prediction of what may happen next become more important as your child gets older.
