## **Kilvrough Visit Suggested Clothing List**

3-4 Long sleeved fleece/sweaters  
3-4 Warm shirts/thermal tops  
T-Shirts – short and long sleeved  
Trousers/track suit bottoms 3-4 pairs (jeans are not suitable)  
Shorts  
Underwear  
Socks (thick pairs for walking not trainer socks)  
Clean clothes for the evening – nothing fancy  
Anorak, jacket or parka (strong windproof with hood if possible)  
Nightclothes  
Training shoes x 2 Pairs if possible (1 for normal use, 1 pair for wet activities)  
Wellington boots  
Washbag (soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste etc.) – no gels please  
2 Towels  
Sun cap and sun cream, Lypsyl or lip salve  
Swimming costume  
Slippers  
Polythene bag for laundry x 2  
Small teddy bear and bedtime reading book  
Plastic water bottle – named  
Single duvet cover, pillow case and a single bottom sheet  
Checklist taped to the inside of the case

Book or notepad for the journey, if you wish.

**No mobile phones or electrical items – there is no signal at Kilvrough!**

### **Medicines**

Any essential medication should be clearly labelled and handed to Mrs Sparks (Medication must be in its original container, with original pharmacy labels and clearly show the expiry date).

Travel sickness – if your child suffers from travel sickness, please ensure they take their medication before the journey and have one for the return journey. During the visit for two days we travel for approximately one hour by minibus. If you think your child would need one for these days, please add extra.

Asthma - if your child suffers from asthma, they should carry their inhaler at all times and a spare one should be given to Mrs Sparks.
