Caroline Luckraft is the teacher in the FSU overseeing all provision

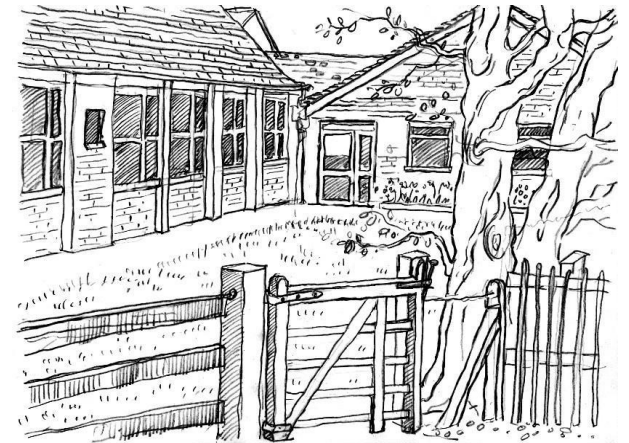

Radley FSU

The FSU caters for children from 3 years old to their entry to primary school in Reception. All children have an entitlement to 15 hours of funded FSU provision from the long term after their third birthday.

You can register your child when they are 2 years old. Please ask the school office for a Registration form.

Parents will be offered five sessions and are asked to take a minimum of 3. Sessions may be taken over full or part days.

Extra sessions if available are charged for separately at £15.00 per session.

Emergency sessions may be requested up to 24 hours in advance in difficult circumstances for a charge of £30.00, if places are available in the FSU.

8.45—12.00pm (Morning)

8.45—3.00pm (All day)

Admissions

Our admissions policy is available for parents to read. **Parents should be aware that entry to the FSU does not lead automatically to a place in the school** and the Local Authority admissions process for children entering Reception in any primary school should be followed.

We are able to take children from Radley and the surrounding area to our FSU whether or not they will apply to attend the primary school. We have excellent transition procedures to all our local primary schools and will ensure that your child's early experiences in our FSU help to smooth their transition to school.

September 2008, the Early Years Foundation Stage, or EYFS, traces every child's early learning experiences from Birth to Five.

Staff in the FSU are very skilled and experienced in planning for all areas of the EYFS through adult led and child initiated activities. Learning takes place both inside and outside using our extensive and secure outdoor space.
