Online Safety Information

Next week 16 – 20 November is national Anti-Bullying Week; this year its theme is 'United Against Bullying'. As part of this week, children will be learning about online safety and cyber bullying, the importance of treating others with respect and to know what to do if they feel upset or uncomfortable with something they encounter online.

We are pleased that the children are confidently using their Google accounts in school to access the Chromebooks, and, where appropriate at home to access Google Classroom. We would like to remind you that children's Google accounts are intended to be used with adult supervision only, for work in school or for home learning. Children should only use their Google email accounts as part of a school computing lesson or to communicate with teachers about their learning, and not to send messages to other children out of school time. We do monitor children's accounts and appreciate your support in keeping an eye on your child's use of their Google account at home.
