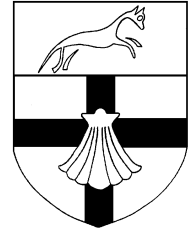

Radley FSU aims to:

- Provide high quality care and education for the children in the foundation unit;
- Work in partnership with parents to help children to learn and develop;
- Offer children and their parents a service which promotes equality and values diversity.

As a member of RFSU your child:

- Is in safe and stimulating environment;
- Is given care and attention, because of our high ratio of adults to children;
- Is encouraged to join with other children and adults to learn together;
- Is helped to take forward her/his learning and development by building on what s/he already knows and can do;
- Has an assigned key person who ensures your child makes progress;
- Is in a setting in which parents are encouraged to be involved

Session Times

For children aged 3-5 years, Monday to Friday 8.45am to 12.00pm (Morning only)

For children aged 3-5 years, Monday to Friday 8.45am to 3.00pm (All day)

Fees

Your child is eligible for government funding the term after their third birthday. Funding will be received directly by the school for a maximum of 15 hours per week (5 sessions).

Extra sessions if available are charged at £15.00 per session. You will be invoiced monthly in advance.

Parents must give us half a term's notice if they wish to remove their children from the FSU and all sessions allocated must be paid for.

Admissions and Registration

We accept children onto our waiting lists at 24 months of age.

Curriculum

Children start to learn about the world around them from the moment they are born. The care and education offered by the FSU helps children to continue to do this by providing them with interesting activities that are right for their age and stage of development. All children before entering Key Stage One experience the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) Curriculum.

Children are observed and assessed using the EYFS and monitoring each child's progress enables us to provide the right activities to help all children move towards their continuing development.

The Role of the Parents/Carers in Early Years Education

RFSU recognise parents as the first and most important educators of their children. All staff see themselves as co-workers with you, in providing care and education for your child. There are many ways in which parents take part in making RFSU a welcoming and stimulating place, such as:

- Exchanging knowledge about their children's needs, activities, interests and progress with staff;
- Sharing their own special interests with the children;
- Helping to provide, make and look after the equipment and materials used in the children's play activities;
- Joining in community activities in which the FSU takes part;
- Fundraising for the Foundation Stage Unit.
