We have put the following in place to support your child's learning at home, these activities are for the next two weeks, taking us up to the Easter Break. We would greatly appreciate your support and encouragement so as to maintain the good progress and momentum we have generated this year.

Subject	Resources	Time daily
Reading for pleasure	Own books or online texts. Use your Reading Record Books to record what you are reading or have a go at using Biblionasium (see below). This allows you to record online what you have read and you can also make comments about the texts. Read and discuss the text with an adult. This could be focusing on the characters, storyline, your favourite part etc	20 minutes minimum
Spelling	Make sure that you can spell the words from the Common Exception sheet. If you are confident in spelling these words, can you practice writing these words in sentences? Challenge yourself to writing a pair in one sentence.	20 minutes
Maths	<u>Espresso Website - Fractions</u> Go to Key stage 1 – Maths – Fractions: You will find a selection of videos and online activities to try. Then go to Printable Resources and complete at least 3. And/ or... <u>Education City – Fractions</u> After logging in go to 'Cherwell Class' Year 1 or Year 2. You will find lots of screens and activities to explore. There are also some printable sheets.	20 – 30 minutes
Maths	For the next two weeks we would have been learning about measuring length and height . You will need to: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Explore some of the activities on the Espresso Website. Go to Key stage 1 – Maths – Measures (just measuring length & height).2. Practice measuring items around your home in centimetres. Try estimating first.3. Find objects that are longer and shorter than 1metre.	20 – 30 minutes

Subject	Activity	Resources
Literacy	This term we have completed a literacy unit on letter writing. Your task is to write me a letter to tell me any of your news. See if you can order the news items in time order. I look forward to hearing what you have been up to!	paper envelope stamp (if you would like to post it to school)
Topic/ Science	Research and produce a personal project about lego. You will find some information about the inventor on the Twinkl website (see below). You could include a photograph or picture of a model that you are proud of.	Twinkl Home resources Internet Lego
Art	Make a piece of art about Spring. This can be with any materials/ art resources that you have at home. Think carefully about which images you will include.	If you do a 'search' on Espresso you will find lots of images and ideas on the season of Spring, including short videos
