Dear Parents,

So far this term for homework, children in Thames Class have been asked to learn their lines and song words for our upcoming play 'Let Loose'. Most children have done an excellent job and our play rehearsals are definitely gaining momentum. They have also been asked to keep up their daily twenty minutes of independent reading.

In school, we have been practicing the Year 5/6 National Curriculum Spellings and children will be tested on these during the week beginning 11th July (two or three shorter tests rather than one long test). Practice at home using Quizlet, Spelling Frame or their own choice is also important. The children have the word list in their Spelling File.

This week children will bring home their CGP Reading and Maths books. They can now work through any pages that have not as yet been completed (20 minutes each week if possible). If children are finding a particular area challenging, they could look through some of the online resources listed in the Homework File on Google Classroom. Any pages they complete can be self-marked with the answers at the back of the book.
